



Vaccine Administration Management System

VAMS Jurisdiction Users,

VAMS release 1.2.5 went into production last night and includes the following enhancements that will improve VAMS usability for all users. Please share this information with your VAMS clinics and employer/organizations.

Employer Module Updates

- **Employer/Organization POCs now have the option to re-send the registration emails to individuals in your organization.** On the “My Employees” tab, Employer/Organization POCs will select the checkbox next to the names of the individuals and then click the “Resend Registration Email” button on the top right of the screen.
 - You can only resend the email one time per hour
 - You can only resend a registration email a maximum of five times per individual
 - You cannot resend a registration email to an individual who has already registered their account
- **Employer/Organization POCs can now edit the first name and last name for individuals in your organization.**
 - You cannot change the name for an individual who has already registered their account
 - The recipient can edit their own First Name and Last name during the registration process and once their account is registered. They cannot change their email address.
- **DELAYED:** The ability for Employer/Organization POCs to add additional Employer/Organization POCs has been delayed until an upcoming release

Healthcare Professional Updates

- **The Healthcare Professional in all clinic types can now backdate the vaccine administration date for all new vaccination events.** This may be especially helpful in low-connectivity areas where healthcare professionals are not able to log vaccinations at the time they occur. This feature is only available at the time of logging the vaccination in VAMS and not for previously entered vaccinations. It is important to note that the system

will identify the person that logs the vaccine in VAMS as the same person who also administered the vaccine.

Inventory Management Updates

- **Inventory lot numbers (Unit of Sale (UoS) and Unit of Use (UoU – vial) can now have a dash in them.** This functionality enables inventory managers to add dashes “-“ as needed when manually logging inventory.

HL7 Updates

- **VAMS can now hold HL7 messages from transmitting if there a technical need to do so for your jurisdiction** (e.g., your IIS has changes in HL7 configuration requirements). In addition, for all jurisdictions, messages will be held if clinic identifiers (Facility ID, Parent Organization ID, etc.) are missing. These messages will be released once the required identifier(s) has been populated. Additional items in 1.2.5:

- Additional enhancements to improve help desk functionality
- Removing alerts displayed to healthcare professionals for recipients who did not report any medical conditions
